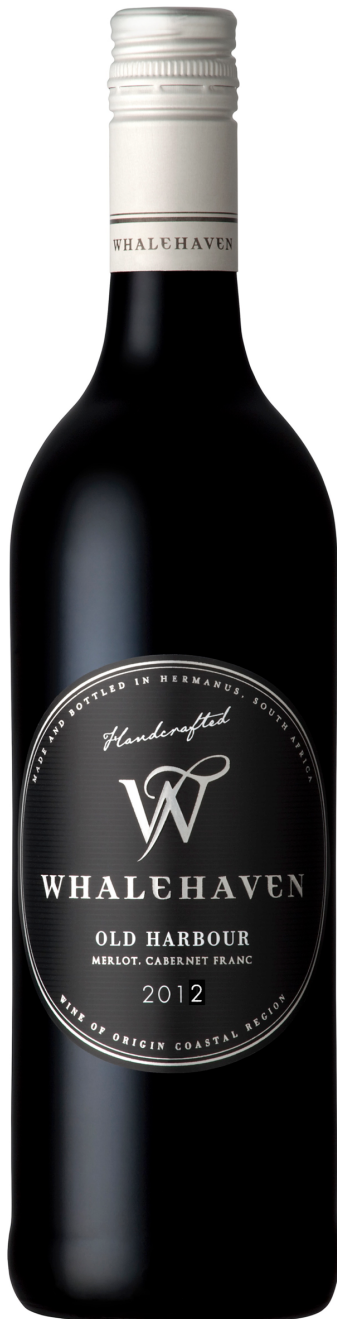




WHALEHAVEN

OLD HARBOUR RED 2016

DESCRIPTION

Whalehaven commemorates the historic Old Harbour that has been a Hermanus landmark since 1855. A mouth filling wine with aromas of cinnamon, red currants and sweet vanilla notes followed by flavours of prunes and pepper lingering over a velvety smooth finish. A wine to enjoy.

VARIETIES

Merlot (65%), Shiraz (20%)

ORIGIN

Wine of Origin Coastal Region

VINIFICATION

The grapes were crushed separately and fermented in stainless steel tanks. Malo-lactic took place in tanks on French and American oak staves. Further maturation took place in 4th and 5th fill French, Hungarian and American 225L oak barrels for 10 months, before the wine was given a light fining and filtered for bottling.
